5 The review in June 2019 identified as good practice, that students' access to university learning resources, including specialist facilities, supports student learning. The College has built on this by ensuring that the induction sessions for students starting in January included link tutors, the Dundee University Student Association, student services and college alumni providing students with identified resources for any queries. Reading lists, materials and other resources are available on the virtual learning environment (VLE). Staff training has been undertaken to ensure that the university policy on reading and resource lists is fully understood and implemented. Students on the art and design programmes are now able to participate in the weekly lecture series with the comparable university cohort. Peer-assisted learning has been introduced, initially with computing students, who are also benefitting from access to specialised resources through the work of their link tutor.

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
