Outcome of the desk-based analysis

1 From the annual return and documentary evidence, the monitoring team concludes that the Washington International Studies Council (WISC) is continuing to maintain academic standards and the quality of student learning opportunities since the January 2021 [Recognition Scheme for Educational Oversight Review](#).

Changes since the last QAA review

2 WISC's typical enrolments of around 140 full-term students per year, have declined since March 2020. The current student numbers stand at 41 full-time equivalent studying on an RQF Level 6 qualification being taught on a one-to-one basis by an average of 30 to 40 Oxford tutors per term.
